After months of hard work and learning, they will have the opportunity to showcase their electric GoKart in the APS Electric Light Parade in December of 2024. It will be a grand celebration of their journey in the EV Innovators Club.

Club Registration and Cost

The cost to be a part of this journey is \$3,500. This includes:

- An Electric GoKart (MotoTec Mud Monster XL 60v 2000w Electric Go Kart)
- A \$1,000 Stipend for Teacher-Sponsor
- Sponsor Kick-Off Event
- Twice-Monthly (September-November)

- Weekly (September-December) Club Activity
- Entry into the APS Electric Light Parade (Saturday, December 7th, 2024)
